



ASQ Section 1302 Phil Shanline Scholarship

General Information

This scholarship is open to residents of the following States attending an institution in one of these States: Nebraska, Kansas, Missouri, Iowa, South Dakota, Wyoming, or Colorado.

A total of **nine** scholarships will be awarded: **Four \$500** based solely on responses to application essay questions; **Four \$500** based on a combination of essay responses and financial need, and **One \$1,000** based on essay response and financial need.

Scholarships will be for use at any post-secondary institution in pursuit of a certificate, diploma, or degree. The funds may be utilized for any expense allowable by the institution to which the checks are sent including tuition, fees, housing, books and other supplies necessary for completion of the recipient's program.

Scholarships will be awarded for the Academic year beginning in August and ending the following August.

Applicants must possess an overall grade point average of at least 2.0 for at least two periods at the last secondary or post-secondary institution which they attended.

Application (HARD COPY) must be received by Section 1302 by March 15th of the current year for award pertinent to the Academic year beginning the following August. Award ceremonies will be held in May and actual checks mailed to institutions no later than September 10th. Depending on constraints of individual institution, an August mailing may be arranged.

Recipients should attend the award ceremony if at all possible.

Applicants must provide supplementary information if requested. This may include verification of financial status.

Instructions

1. All applications must be received in HARD COPY by March 15th of the current year. All applications must include a formal transcript from the applicants last secondary or post-secondary institution.
2. The Scholarship application period will be from January 1 of the calendar year through March 15th.
3. Scholarship applications should be typed. Data will be accepted if hand written, but essay responses MUST be typed. Single Spaced, 12 point font size and Times New Roman, or Arial are preferred format.
