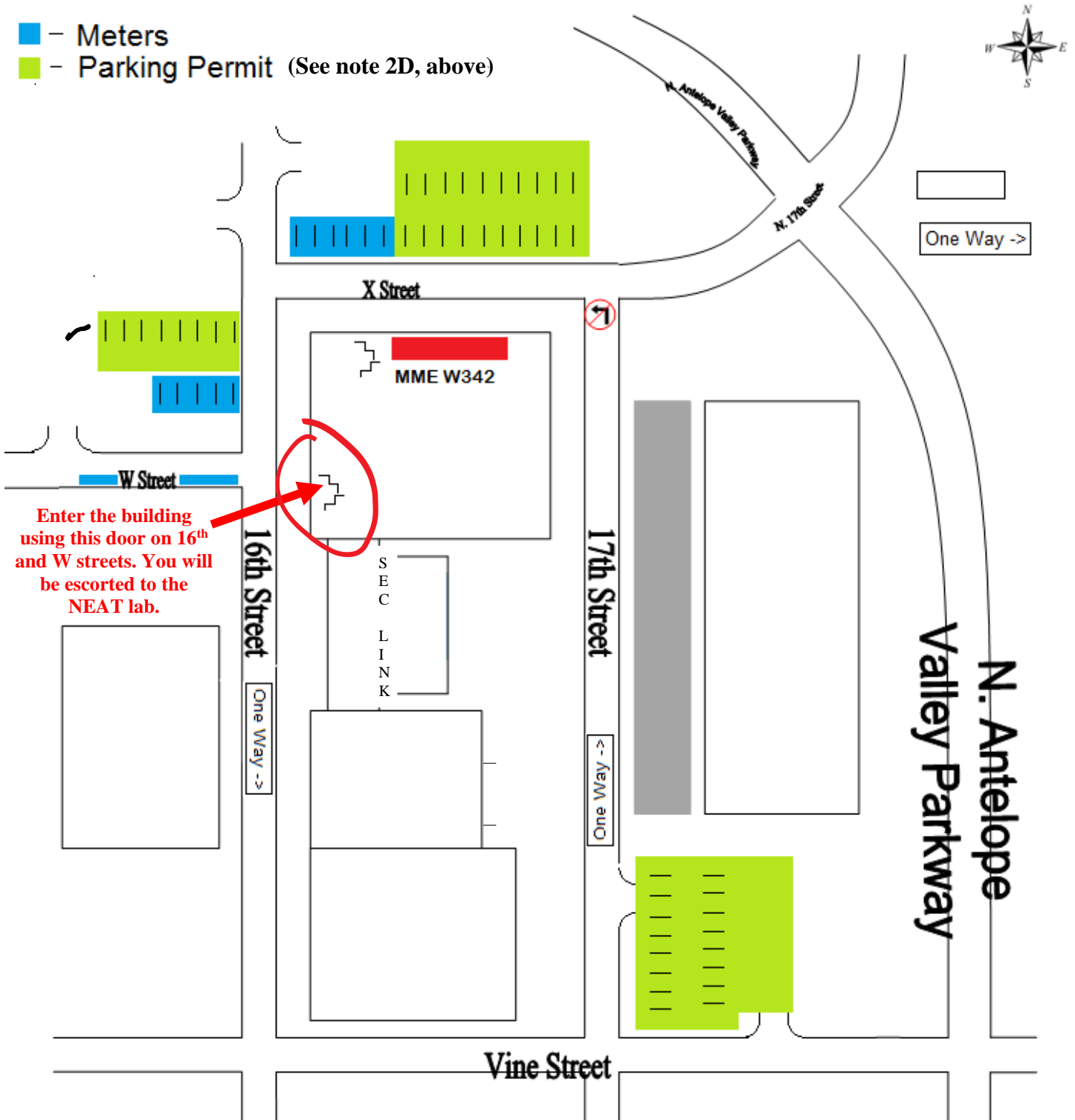


1. **RSVP your attendance by Sep. 16.**

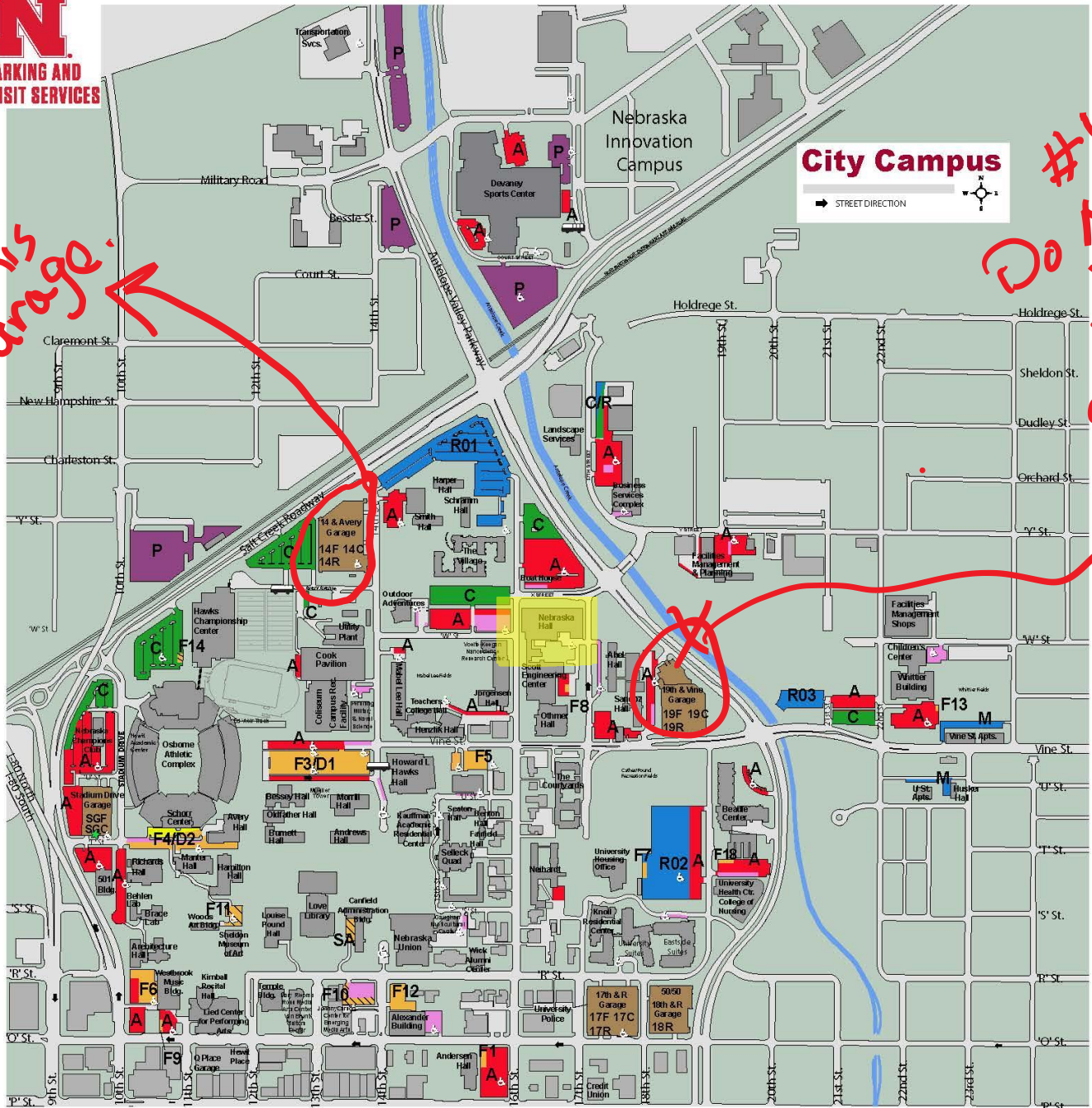
